A-AWA Staff Serge Team is one of the leads for LSS Asylum clinic. During the month of July, the team assisted clients in two sets of workshops. Staff Serge team supported two days of Dari workshop and two days of Pashto workshop. A-AWA Staff Serge has five Case Aides. Each Case Aide helped five to six clients in completing their Asylum documents. One Asylum document for one client takes more than ten hours.

It is a lengthy process, but we are more then delighted to help and rescue our Afghans through their Asylum journey.
