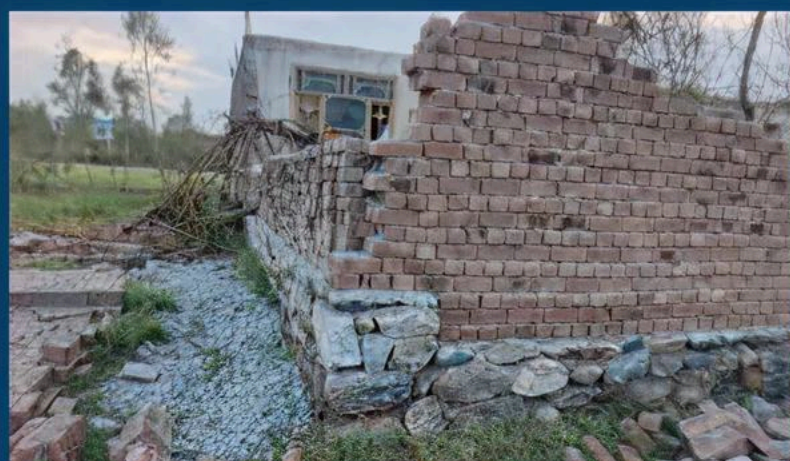
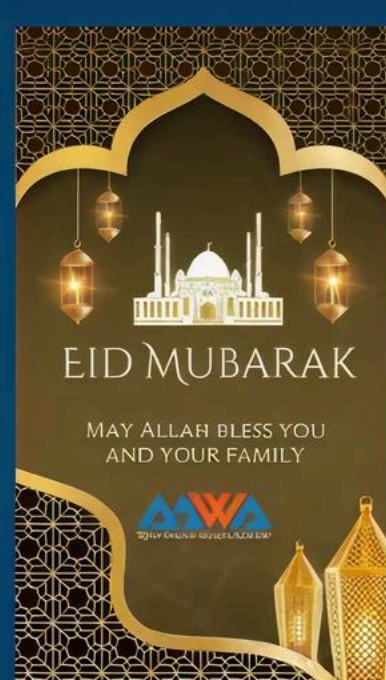
AAWA's Impact: Fundraising Success for Ramadan and Baghlan Relief Efforts
